Call to Awareness – 3 Bells

Good morning. If you are new with us today, my name is Rev. Diana Johnson, Pastor and Spiritual Director of Mystic Heart Spiritual Center, *and I am Chris Johnson, Prayer Practitioner* and we want to welcome you Home.

Our theme for the month of September is *Living from the Overflow*. And this morning, we are going to lead you on a meditative journey... we've titled the service for today *I Am That*. We believe that each one of us is on a journey of the soul... a journey that allows us to grow and evolve as individuals through this life experience, and to maintain that growth as we move from one lifetime to another.

I invite you now to get comfortable and settle into stillness, allowing whatever is happening right now to simply be... relaxing into this experience, letting yourself be held... letting go of everything else for the next hour. Let your body, mind and soul rest, becoming absolutely still as you allow yourself to be infused with the meditative tone of Taizé... no need to remember the words that are spoken... just allow them to wash over you...

Now, let's take a couple of slow, deep breaths, inhaling through your nose and exhaling through your mouth, and if you feel comfortable doing so, allowing your mouth to open just a little bit. This slight movement allows the muscles in your face to relax... settling into the heart space, where there is only Peace, where there is only Love, where there is only here and now... and feel into this moment together, into the gathering of this sacred community.

I would like to share, as I did at the last Taizé, a short illustration from the Buddhist tradition: "In the realm of the god Indra is a vast net that stretches infinitely in all directions. In each *eye* of the net is a single brilliant, perfect jewel. Each jewel also reflects every other jewel, infinite in number, and each of the reflected images of the jewels bears the image of all the other jewels — infinity to infinity. Whatever affects one jewel effects them all." This metaphor illustrates the interconnectedness, the interdependence, of all phenomena. Everything contains and reflects everything else. At the same time, each individual thing stands on its own as a unique expression.

Like the Net of Indra, visualize with me now a global web of consciousness, each of us a point of Light, all connected across the planet, all beings who in this moment, might be

sitting in meditation or prayer, might be attending sacred services... acknowledging the Presence of the Divine... consciously connected by our common purpose... feeling the collective intention that brought us here... feeling the deep devotion to that which is bigger than we are... feeling the impulse to grow and evolve that's awakening within us...

"Underneath the sea of our lives, which alternate between storm and calm, ebb and flow, lies the unfathomable abyss of pure being. This is the soul. It has no limits, no need for anything to be added. It is complete within itself... It transcends all categories, swallows all opposites. It simply is."

It is the inner shrine, offering sacred space for devotion and communion to unfold... offering Its Holy Voice as Inner Knowing... as Guidance.

Christian Mystic, Thomas Merton, tells us that, "Every moment and every event of every man's life on earth plants something in his soul." Perhaps this has even been true through many lifetimes. It seems to me, then, that we ought to be very careful what we allow to be planted. The soul knows what is nourishing... it knows what will bring fulfillment... it knows who and what we are meant to be... and it will forever guide us in the direction of our Highest Purpose, if only we become quiet and still... and listen.
