"We shall be known by the company we keep..." What does this mean? Is it true?

"...by the ones who circle round to tend these fires." What does it mean to 'tend the fires?'

"We shall be known by the ones who sow and reap the seeds of change alive from deep within the earth." What are the seeds of change that are alive right now in the world?

Why do you suppose the song speaks of these changes as being alive from deep within the earth?

"It is time now, it is time now that we thrive. It is time we lead ourselves into the well." It is time now. Not tomorrow, not next year, not when it's more convenient to do the work, to make the changes. It doesn't say *survive*, it says *thrive*.

What a powerful word. What does human thriving look like?

And what does it mean to lead ourselves into the well?

"It is time now, and what a time to be alive. In this Great Turning we shall learn to lead in Love."

What is *this Great Turning*?

The Great Turning is a name for the shift from the Industrial Growth Society we live in to a life-sustaining civilization. People are realizing that our needs can be met without destroying our world. We have the technical knowledge, the communication tools, and material resources to grow enough good, ensure clean air and water, and meet rational energy needs. It is believed that future generations, if there is a livable world for them, will look back at the epochal transition we are making to a life-sustaining society, and may well call this the time of the Great Turning. It is happening *now*. With or without our conscious participation.

Why is this a Conscious Conversation at a Sunday Service? Why is this a topic for our Spiritual Consideration?

With humanity serving as God's hands, feet, hearts, and voices, *there is no reason we cannot have such a world*.

With nothing and no one in its way, we are creating it now as we speak our Powerful Word. And so it is...Amen.
